

The Organizing Committee has to abide by the following rules in their participant selection in the following order:

1. Any applicant having participated in more than 3 official EESTEC events in the running association year, not counting Operational Events and any event containing General Meetings of EESTEC International, are to be selected only if there are not any other applicants to be given a spot to.
2. Select, if possible, an equal number of participants from each Commitment of which members have applied.
3. In accordance with the priority lists sent by Commitments, the Organizing Committee must aim for a gender balance. Individuals identifying as third gender are counted as female unless specified otherwise by the International Board.
  - (a) Exempt from this rule are gender-biased exclusive workshops.
4. In accordance with the priority lists sent by Commitments, the Organizing Committee should aim for a geographic balance among its participants.
  - (a) Exempt from this are geographically-biased exclusive workshops.

Should following these rules pose a non-neglectable challenge for the success of the event in question, the Organizing Committee may contact the International Board in accordance with whom a participants list not following the rules above can be created.
